Mount Taylor is the "Turquoise Mountain" and "Sacred Mountain of the South" to the Navajo People. It is a high mountain peak with an elevation of 11,389 feet, located just west of Albuquerque. This high peak possesses grand views opportunities for wild life watching and crisp clean air. This peak is home to the New Mexico Quad Race in the winter and is one of the best hikes in the Albuquerque area. This is a strenuous 8 mile hike, so you should be in good physical condition. Bring lunch, snacks, lots of water, good clothes and sturdy foot wear. Cost is \$15 a person. Call 846-1499.
